Dr. McBryde is currently Ankle and Foot Fellowship Director at the Andrews Sports Medicine and Orthopaedic Center in Birmingham. He has global sports injury responsibilities at all levels. Professional activities include committee work with the AAOS, the AOA and numerous other orthopaedic groups. He was President of the NC Orthopaedic Society and the Southern Orthopaedic Association in 1985, the Southern Medical Association in 1994 and the Clinical Orthopaedic Society in 2008. He is a member of the Davidson College Athletic Hall of Fame. He has been a Honduras physician. As academic

Chair of Orthopaedics at several Southern universities and twice Olympic Team Physician he has traveled, written and spoken widely on sports injuries of the ankle and lower extremity.



James R. Urbaniak, MD

Dr. Urbaniak is recognized as a pioneer in the replantation of severed digits and hands. During his career he has conducted significant research in the area of microsurgical reconstruction of traumatized extremities and avascular necrosis of the femoral head. While at Duke, Dr. Urbaniak built the academic orthopaedic division into one of the largest in the country and developed a basic research program that now has more than 10 million dollars of NIH funding. Dr. Urbaniak is the Virginia Flowers Baker Professor of Orthopaedics for Duke University Medical Center, Durham, North Carolina.

BARCELONA, SPAIN
