Medical Student Competition

Eligibility:

- Accredited U.S. allopathic or osteopathic medical schools can send up to 3 teams
- Each team can consist of up to 4 medical students (from the same school); only one team member per team can be graduating within 30 days of the competition;
- Participants must be an SMA Member (membership is FREE for medical students). Not a member? Click here for member info: <https://sma.org/membership/member-signup/student/>
- Participants must be a permanent resident or citizen of the United States, or have DACA status;
- Participants must be registered for the [SMA's Annual Scientific Assembly](#), and attend/participate in-person (details: sma.org/assembly)

Resident Competition

Eligibility:

- ACGME or AOA accredited residency training programs of any specialty can send 1 team;
- Each team can consist of up to 4 Residents (from the same program);
- Preliminary residents in a program and transitional residents in their first year of training are eligible to participate;
- Participants must be an SMA Member (click here for member info: <https://sma.org/membership/member-signup/resident/>);
- Participants must be registered for the SMA's [Annual Scientific Assembly](#), and attend/participate in person (details: sma.org/assembly)
- Chief residents and fellows in sub-specialty training programs are not eligible to compete.
